After planting a church in Philippi, with much difficulty and suffering, Paul's team travels to Thessalonica. **Philip of Macedon** was the namesake of the City of Philippi. Philip was the father of **Alexander the Great**. Alexander's half-sister was **Thessalonike** - same dad, different moms. There's a **connection** between **Philippi** and **Thessalonica** - two principal cities in the Roman Province of **Macedonia**. **Planting Churches in Principal Cities was Paul's strategy**. That way, those churches could, later, **evangelize the whole surrounding region**, around those Principal Cities. Thessalonica was quite literally at the **cross roads** of two major trading routes and it had a **major shipping harbor**, as well. Thus, just like Philippi, it was a **Principal Roman City** and was at the cross roads of major trade routes, as well. **This was a God-led Gospel Spreading Strategy**.
