1. What does “more fair-minded” or “more noble-minded” mean?

Who is being compared in this case? (hint – context – what “facility” were they meeting in?)

2. When we look at 1 Thessalonians chapters 1 thru 3, we see a similarity with Berean Jews and the Thessalonian Believers in Jesus → in what aspects?

What does “eagerness” apply to in Acts 17:11?

3. In Acts 17:11 – what did the Berean Jews do **daily** when they were meeting with Paul and Silas?

Why is that so important? (hint: 2 Timothy 2:15; 2 Timothy 3:16-4:4; 1 John 4:1)

How does this help us, now, that we are saved in Christ? Did you notice the word “**daily**”?

4. Acts 17:12 – what categories of people believed the Gospel in Berea?

5. Who came from Thessalonica to cause riots against Paul and Silas and their teachings?

What was their motivation? (hint: Acts 17:5)

Why were they following Paul and Silas?

What else does this imply, for us, and missionaries, today?

Can those kinds of people (those that oppose the Gospel) be Pioneers for their own belief systems, bringing or planting their belief systems into new areas?
