P – Pastoral-Eldership – Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastor-Teacher → *** 4-Fold Leadership ***

- D Deacons (ref. 1 Timothy 3:8-13; Acts 6:1-7) A.T.L. stands for: Action Team Leadership

(also ref.: 1 Timothy 5:17-18; Hebrews 13:7,17)

Massively Appreciative, Loving, Kind and Respectful.

→ Willingly submitting to their leadership. Follow, Obey, Trust

Why do you think God wants it this way?

 → It is how we relate to Christ, as they follow Christ under His Leadership – we follow our local church leadership according to God's Word – it must always align with God's Word. It reflects our heart toward Christ as we follow Christ, together, as the leadership follows Christ, all as a Body, local. It is a witness to the World.
