

Galatians 6:11-18 (NKJV)

See with what large letters I have written to you with my own hand! 12 As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these would compel you to be circumcised, only that they may not suffer persecution for the cross of Christ. 13 For not even those who are circumcised keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh. 14 But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our LORD Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

#### Galatians 6:11-18 (NKJV)

- <sup>15</sup> For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a NEW CREATION.
- <sup>16</sup> And as many as walk according to this rule, PEACE and MERCY be upon them, and upon the Israel of God.
- <sup>17</sup> From now on let no one trouble me, for I bear in my body the marks of the LORD Jesus.
- <sup>18</sup> Brethren, the grace of our LORD Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.

- Did Paul have eye problems? Was this the "thorn" in the flesh a sickness of his eyes?
   See with what large letters I have written to you with my own hand! (Gal. 6:11)
  - 2 Cor. 12:1-10 states that Paul had a vision of heaven and then was given a "thorn in the flesh", a "messenger of Satan" to buffet him so that he wouldn't boast about it. He asked 3 times for it to be taken away, but God did not, but God said to Paul: "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Was this "thorn in the flesh" eye problems?

Did Paul have eye problems? Was this the "thorn" in the flesh – a sickness of his eyes?
 See with what large letters I have written to you with my own hand! (Gal. 6:11)

Gal. 4:13-16 - You know that because of physical infirmity I preached the gospel to you at the first. 14 And my trial which was in my flesh you did not despise or reject, but you received me as an angel of God, even as Christ Jesus. 15 What then was the blessing you enjoyed? For I bear you witness that, if possible, you would have plucked out your own eyes and given them to me. 16 Have I therefore become your enemy because I tell you the truth?

- Did Paul have eye problems? Was this the "thorn" in the flesh a sickness of his eyes?
   See with what large letters I have written to you with my own hand! (Gal. 6:11)
  - → Analysis → Maybe but it is inconclusive. But books, chapters in books have been written about this. More than likely Paul had some injuries from the persecution he received in the region of Galatia when he was stoned almost to death in Lystra (see Acts 14:19, in context). He might have written large for their sakes, not his, just to show it is him who wrote it (keepin' it simple).

The trend / fad – during Paul's time was to mix the Old
Testament Law of Moses in with the New Covenant – Gospel
Message and Teachings – Judaizers / Hebrew Roots
Movement Legalism (HRML). Thus, they would not offend the
Jewish Establishment and not suffer persecution. But, it
nullifies the Cross of Christ (His Crucifixion, Death, Burial &
Resurrection, His Finished Work of Redemption)

#### 2. Again, Why did Paul write this letter to the Galatians?

<sup>12</sup> As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these would compel you to be circumcised, only that they may NOT suffer persecution for the cross of Christ. <sup>13</sup> For not even those who are circumcised keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh.

The Judaizers / Hebrew Roots Movement Legalism (HRML) don't keep the whole Law of Moses (from Exodus through Deuteronomy) as written. Even back then Jesus told folks that unless their righteousness exceed that of the scribes and Pharisees, they wouldn't even experience God's Kingdom.

#### Jesus said:

<sup>17</sup> "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. 18 For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law UNTIL ALL is FULFILLED. 19 Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments, and teaches men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. <sup>20</sup> For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by NO means enter the kingdom of heaven." Matt. 5:17-20 → Jesus is the ONE Who Fulfilled All of the LAW on our behalf. It is Fulfilled - I don't have to fulfill it nor am I under the LAW, anymore. My righteousness is Christ's imputed to me.

The Judaizers / Hebrew Roots Movement Legalism (HRML) today like to use Matt. 5:17-19, but skip vs. 20. Also, they don't really read it ... there is a condition for the LAW of Moses to No Longer Be In Effect ... When All of the LAW is FULFILLED. Yeshua / Jesus Christ / The Messiah of Israel – He Fulfilled it ALL – thus, now, the New Covenant is IN EFFECT (from Acts 2 onward – from the day of Pentecost)

The Judaizers / Hebrew Roots Movement Legalism (HRML) back then focused on the "entry point" into Judaism – circumcision of all the males of the household. Today, the same HRML folks, instead focus on keeping the Sabbath, all the Feast Days (see Leviticus 23) instead of circumcision. It is the same thing repackaged. Keeping the Law to Be Saved, and Keeping the Law to Keep your salvation.



#### 2. Again, Why did Paul write this letter to the Galatians?

<sup>12</sup> As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these would compel you to be circumcised, only that they may NOT suffer persecution for the cross of Christ. <sup>13</sup> For not even those who are circumcised keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh.

What purpose then does the law serve? It was added because of transgressions, UNTIL the Seed (the Messiah) should come to whom the promise was made; and it was appointed through angels by the hand of a mediator. (Gal. 3:19)

#### 2. Again, Why did Paul write this letter to the Galatians?

<sup>12</sup> As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these would compel you to be circumcised, only that they may NOT suffer persecution for the cross of Christ. <sup>13</sup> For not even those who are circumcised keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh.

Therefore the law was our tutor (teacher / schoolmaster) to BRING us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

<sup>25</sup> But after faith has come, we are NO LONGER UNDER A TUTOR. (Gal. 3:24)

No Longer under A Tutor = No Longer Under the Law to obey it – to follow it ... we in Christ, now, in the New Covenant.

But if you are led by the Spirit, you are NOT UNDER the LAW.

(Gal. 5:18)

The Law of Moses shows me that I am a sinner (a tutor) - and leads me to the **Messiah – to the Cross** - then I am NO longer under the Law but I'm **IN CHRIST** 

So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves.... But when you are directed by the Spirit, you are not under obligation to the law of Moses. **Galatians 5:16, 18** 

3. Those that COMPEL / FORCE / Make You Feel Guilty - to follow the LAW – have some hidden Agendas.

<sup>12</sup> As many as DESIRE to make a GOOD SHOWING in the flesh, these would COMPEL you to be circumcised, only that they may NOT suffer persecution for the cross of Christ. <sup>13</sup> For not even those who are circumcised keep the law, but they DESIRE to have you circumcised that they may BOAST in your flesh.

These HRML folks have a hidden agenda. Since, they are NOT being led by the Holy Spirit, according to the Word of God, to Glorify Christ – they have a sinful, earthly, human agenda, using selfish, self-righteous, and self-gratifying goals. They want to Boast About their Accomplishments. They are being led by something else, instead of pleasing God His way

3. Those that COMPEL / FORCE / Make You Feel Guilty - to follow the LAW – have some hidden Agendas.

<sup>12</sup> As many as DESIRE to make a GOOD SHOWING in the flesh, these would COMPEL you to be circumcised, only that they may NOT suffer persecution for the cross of Christ. <sup>13</sup> For not even those who are circumcised keep the law, but they DESIRE to have you circumcised that they may BOAST in your flesh.

These HRML folks have a hidden agenda. They cannot be sincerely wrong (by accident, by mistake). Since, they have Acts 15, the book of Galatians, and the book of Hebrews all singing the same chorus AGAINST what they are teaching and believing, etc. and they are NOT being led by the Spirit. They must twist Scripture to their own ends and mislead the many.

But may it never be that I would boast, except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. Galatians 6:14

What are we to boast about? Jesus Christ (or Yeshua h'Mashiach for those HRML folks)
We are to boast about Him, His Love, Grace, Mercy, Truth ...
His Crucifixion, Death, Burial and Resurrection – as ENOUGH.
I am NO LONGER UNDER the Authority of the World System of Fallen Human Nature and of Sin. I've been Crucified!

4. The Only "thing" we should boast about is the CROSS.

<sup>14</sup> But God forbid that I should BOAST except in the CROSS of our LORD Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. <sup>15</sup> For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a new creation.

What are we to boast about? Jesus Christ / Yeshua
We are to boast about Him, His Love, Grace, Mercy, Truth ...
His Crucifixion, Death, Burial and Resurrection – as ENOUGH.
I am NO LONGER UNDER the Authority of the Law of Moses,
but under Christ's Authority in the New Covenant.
I've been Crucified!

4. The Only "thing" we should boast about is the CROSS.

<sup>14</sup> But God forbid that I should BOAST except in the CROSS of our LORD Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. <sup>15</sup> For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a New Creation.

If a person has already been circumcised before coming to Christ or if a person has never been circumcised before coming to Christ – that is NOT the focus – but being a New Creation in Christ Jesus (in Messiah Yeshua). Being Transformed / Changed / New – in Christ – He does the changing and transforming. It is undeniable and visible.

4. The Only "thing" we should boast about is the CROSS.

<sup>14</sup> But God forbid that I should BOAST except in the CROSS of our LORD Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. <sup>15</sup> For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a New Creation.

In vs. 15 he is NOT talking about a person AFTER being saved – that they seek to follow the Law of Moses by being circumcised – he's already talked about that, previously, and made a very compelling case of it. He is talking about how they are when they come to Christ. Look at 1 Cor. 7:18 →

#### 1 Corinthians 7:18:

Was anyone called while circumcised? Let him NOT become uncircumcised. Was anyone called while uncircumcised? Let him NOT be circumcised.

Thus, whatever physical state a person is in, let him/her be that as led by God according to Scripture, etc.

4. The Only "thing" we should boast about is the CROSS.

<sup>14</sup> But God forbid that I should BOAST except in the CROSS of our LORD Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. <sup>15</sup> For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a New Creation.

In Colossians 2:11 – Paul shows How Christ FULFILLED the Law for us – even regarding Circumcision: In Him you were also CIRCUMCISED with the CIRCUMCISION made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the CIRCUMCISION of Christ, <sup>12</sup> buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were RAISED with Him through FAITH in the WORKING of God, who RAISED Him from the dead.

- <sup>16</sup> And as many as walk according to THIS RULE, PEACE and MERCY be upon them, and upon the Israel of God. <sup>17</sup> From now on let no one trouble me, for I bear in my body the marks of the LORD Jesus. <sup>18</sup> Brethren, the grace of our LORD Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.
- → And as many as walk according to THIS RULE?

  What RULE → All the Teaching from Galatians 1:1 unto 6:15

  This is why I asked y'all to read all of Galatians and re-listen / re-watch previous sermons on this because there is a blessing here but it is CONDITIONAL.

  Have you studied up on this? Are you Doing this "Rule"?

- <sup>16</sup> And as many as walk according to THIS RULE, PEACE and MERCY be upon them, and upon the Israel of God. <sup>17</sup> From now on let no one trouble me, for I bear in my body the marks of the LORD Jesus. <sup>18</sup> Brethren, the grace of our LORD Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.
- → the Israel of God? Again, books, volumes, chapters, sermons have been written and said about this "concept" or "phrase". Is this different than "Israel" the genetic descendant of Jacob, son of Isaac, grandson of Abraham? "Maybe"? (notice the quotes). It is more than likely those who are Israelis (genetic) who are in Christ (in Messiah) such as Paul (Rabbi Shaul / Saul) just to be biblically consistent. (ref. Romans 11)

- → stop troubling me? Paul was frustrated and tired of folks like these HRML (Judaizers) that kept wanting to focus on "works" and what we MUST DO to keep the Law of Moses, etc. Have you been there? Do you have the SCARS to prove it? If not, why not? You only earn battle scars by Spreading the Gospel, DEFENDING THE FAITH, etc. by doing it.

  Are you? If not, why not.

- <sup>16</sup> And as many as walk according to THIS RULE, PEACE and MERCY be upon them, and upon the Israel of God. <sup>17</sup> From now on let no one trouble me, for I bear in my body the MARKS of the LORD Jesus. <sup>18</sup> Brethren, the grace of our LORD Jesus Christ be with your spirit. - → stop troubling me? Do you have the SCARS to prove it? If not, why not? You only earn battle scars by Spreading the Gospel, DEFENDING THE FAITH, etc. by doing it.

  Are you? If not, why not.

Yes, and ALL who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution. (2 Timothy 3:12) → Compromisers, will not . . .

→ stop troubling me? You only earn battle scars by Spreading the Gospel, Defending the Faith, etc. by doing it.

Yes, and ALL who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution. (2 Timothy 3:12) → Compromisers, will not . . . Paul did not preach circumcision or that Gentiles coming to Christ must keep the law – thus he focused on the Cross of Christ. He preached the Genuine, Real, True Gospel of Christ.

<sup>16</sup> And as many as walk according to THIS RULE, PEACE and MERCY be upon them, and upon the Israel of God. <sup>17</sup> From now on let no one trouble me, for I bear in my body the MARKS of the LORD Jesus. <sup>18</sup> Brethren, the Grace of our LORD Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.

Paul always wanted the best for the churches he wrote to, especially those he was instrumental in Planting, such as these Galatian churches. He knew most of the folks pretty well, as well. It was personal, it was family to him. So it is today, with us ... we must want the best, even after the Rebuke. We all want those who've been caught in sin or false doctrine to Repent and come back. Paul is a great example for us. GRACE
